DAY GUESTS

All our day rooms come with tea and coffee making facilities. Unfortunately we cannot provide meals for groups, but individuals may pre-book a meal at lunch time.

The Chapel is usually available throughout the day and guests are more than welcome to join us at any of our offices (times of worship). With advance notice the Chapel is available to groups for worship.

All our guests are welcome to make use of our library at any time during the day and to enjoy our garden.

ROOMS AVAILABLE

COMMON ROOM – A large, bright room capable of accommodating up to 25 people. This room is ideal for Parish days or prayer groups.

This room is only available at certain times and must be pre-booked.

FRONT VISITOR'S ROOM – A large room capable of accommodating 8-10 people, but is cosy enough for an individual.

UPSTAIRS ROOM – A large, light airy room that is ideal for studying in, with easy access to the library.

CHAPEL ROOM – Smaller and adjacent to the Chapel, this room in a peaceful corner of the house is particularly suitable for a quiet day retreat.

DAY ROOMS IN THE MAIN CONVENT

RESIDENTIAL GUESTS

Our guest house is situated about 100 yards from the main convent. There is accommodation either for individuals or groups of up to 8 people.

There is a sitting room and a dining room/kitchen where drinks and light refreshments are always available.

Our guests eat breakfast at the cottage but all other meals are eaten with the sisters in the refectory in the main building.

The guest cottage is ideal for a small group (maximum of 8) such as a cell group or ministry team who wish to spend some time together.

Guests come for all sorts of reasons; sometimes alone, sometimes to share time with a friend or sometimes as part of a small group.

This is a place to come for rest, a retreat, to make decisions, study, regain strength for difficult life situations, or to join in the Community's worship.

You can enjoy relaxing in the garden and making use of the library, getting assistance for your prayer life and faith journey, or just sleep and find peace and quiet away from the stresses of daily life.

We try to safeguard the quiet and silence of the cottage and can also provide 'accompanying on the way' for those who may find this helpful.
